This course prepares the student to give nursing assistance at a basic level under the supervision of a registered nurse. The certified nursing assistant course provides the opportunity to learn the basic skills that enable the nursing assistant to maintain a proper physical and emotional patient environment, report and record observations, provide assistance in personal hygiene, assist with nutrition, elimination, emergency situations, and general patient care. This course consists of 188 hours, including 98 hours of class time, 20 hours of lab, and 70 hours of clinical. Cost of this class includes the fee for First Aid/CPR and course text.

Participants must be registered CNA's with the equivalent of one year of experience in long-term care.

- Evidence of 2080 hours experience as a CNA
- Two letters of reference from supervising RN's (one may be from DON)

Paid Feeding Assistant Training

In this program, learners acquire the information and skills necessary to qualify them to provide assistance with eating and drinking to residents in long-term care facilities. Participants must be at least 15 years of age. This four-session program will focus on: interpersonal communication and social interaction; feeding skills; infection control; assisting with eating and hydration; resident's rights; assistive devices for eating; dementia; specialized feeding and intake problems; safety and emergency procedures, including the Heimlich maneuver; normal behavior and change; and reporting procedures. Instruction will consist of classroom, lab, and clinical experience. A great program for those considering a career in the health care field or for individuals motivated by a desire to help those in need.
